### SEVENTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

#### First Reading: 1 Kings 3:5, 7-12

Solomon, realizing that he will succeed his father David as King of Israel and Judah, begs the Lord to give him wisdom and understanding in order to rule his people well. The Lord grants his request saying, "...there will come no one to equal you."

#### Second Reading: Romans 8:28-30

## A New Translation of the Roman Missal

A CONTINUING COLUMN

### The Penitential Rite: the "Confiteor"

The new translation helps to foster a more humble, sorrowful attitude toward God as we confess our sins; it helps us recognize that sinning against God is no light matter. The revised translation of this prayer helps us express even more heartfelt contrition, "I have **greatly sinned**", and humbly admit that one has sinned "**through my fault, through my fault, through my most grievous fault, therefore**". And the more we are aware of the terrible offense of sin, our prayer here in the introductory rites of the Mass prepares us to beg, three times for God's mercy. For example, when we deeply feel sorrow over our actions, we sometimes apologize several times... "I'm so sorry... I really regret doing that... Please forgive me." The language of the 'Confiteor' is that of Psalm 51, the *Miserere*: "For I acknowledge my offense, and my sin is before me always." (51:5) We can now come properly disposed to celebrate the Eucharist worthily.

**Next week:** "Have mercy on us, O Lord".

## Lectors

TRAINING PROVIDED

Members of the Ministry of Lectors proclaim the Word of God at all liturgical functions of the parish.

- **What is required to become a part of this ministry?**  
Availability (scheduled), ability to proclaim well publicly, an appreciation of the written Word of God, good grooming, and appropriate attire
- **Who can participate in this ministry?**  
Any confirmed practicing Catholic, usually sophomore in high school and up. You will receive a practical session (to assess ability to read publicly and to give public speaking tools if needed).
- **What is the time commitment?**  
Usually about once a month on a Saturday evening or Sunday morning, plus prep time of going over the readings at home. Lectors must arrive fifteen minutes before Mass to pray the lectors' prayer, to make sure that the lectionary and lector's binder are in order, and to familiarize themselves with the Prayers of the Faithful. Confession twice annually and availability for extraordinary liturgies would also be required.
