Below is a list of Confirmation Preparation important information for your records.

Attendance

Attendance is imperative! Absences are allowed only because of illness and other unavoidable crisis conflicts. If a candidate misses more than one class your teen must attend the make-up class scheduled for April 22.

If more than 2 classes are missed the candidate **may** be required to reschedule the reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Attendance for the entire class session is required.
No coming late or leaving early.

If a candidate leaves the grounds without permission they may be expelled from the program.

Service Hours

8 Volunteer hours must be completed each year for a total of 16 confirmation service hours.

All volunteer hours must be done in our parish community.

Candidates must sign in and out of their service project on a list that will be provided.

Behavior

Use of cell phones is not permitted. Cell phones will be confiscated and will only be returned directly to a parent or guardian.

There is a dress code for all Confirmation candidates' activities. Modest attire is required. Anyone not dressed appropriately, will be sent home and counted as absent for that session.

Reverent behavior is required in Church. No talking, eating, gum chewing or calling out.
